Discussion Questions:

3. Read Matthew 22:34-39. What is the difference in this passage between loving God and loving people? How do you love someone “as yourself”?
4. Read Luke 19:5-9. Why did Luke mention, “the spot” to show importance for this story? What was Zacchaeus’ response? What was Jesus’ response?
5. Embrace the power of the front porch. What are conversation topics that you naturally gravitate toward (i.e./ sports, hobbies, weather, clothing logo, tattoos, etc.)?

- What if you rearrange your schedule this week to engage people like Jesus did?
