Discussion Questions:

1. Have you ever had a holiday or special occasion that didn't go as planned? How did you feel in that moment, and what did you learn from it?
2. Can you think of a time when you chose to see something disappointing from a positive angle?
3. What are some signs that you may be making yourself the "main character" in a situation? How does that perspective impact your relationships with others?
4. How does Paul's comparison of Adam's choice and Jesus' gift resonate with you? What does it mean for you to shift from an "old humanity" mindset to a "new humanity" mindset?
5. Why is it often difficult to let go of control in our lives? How does trusting Jesus at the center of your life bring freedom?
6. Jonathan mentions three ways to imitate Jesus: choosing to go last, praying for those who hurt us, and overserving. Which of these feels most challenging for you, and why?
